The fabulous village of Montriond hides many treasures to be discovered throughout the year, created during its separation from the town of Saint-Jean-d'Aulps on July 21, 1740, the name Montriond means « Mont Arrondi » which means « rounded mountain » in reference to « Mont Rond » the mountain which dominates the lake and the bell tower.

The -t is silent in Savoyard language, so you will be able to hear elders pronounce Monrion, but this usage is only rarely used by the inhabitants of the town and this avoids confusing it with the village "Morillon" which is located on the other side of the valley, after Taninges.

Montriond is now in the heart of the Portes du Soleil area, offering a large area of ski and mountain bike trails but retaining its village charm with its unique bell tower church, its inhabitants and its small shops.

The village of Montriond is to be discovered at any time of the year and each season offers a spectacle of sweet flavors.





Propriété Bel Air

Did you know that it is in a very old building dating back over a century that the Balzac apartment is located today.

Built at the end of the 1870s by Mr. Burnoud, a Parisian who came to settle in the village of Montriond with his wife, he named this property, Chalet Bel -Air!

A place by the side of the road inviting to exchange and sharing, a meeting place where the villagers met after working in the fields, thus, this place naturally turned into a guesthouse, then into a tavern where the inhabitants gathered to celebrate the end of the war in 1918.



C h a l e t B e l - A i r

The Bel Air chalet was redesigned by the French architect René Faublée, also author of the Notre-Dame-des-Prisonniers chapel in Avoriaz and in the 60s to give birth to the Chalet de la Colonie du XIV ° adapted to receive many more world, to offer mountain holidays to many children, organized by the 14th arrondissement of Paris, a massive structure, with heavy and raw materials and linear lines, fitted out at that time for a summer camp in the 14th arrondissement de Paris, which later became Le Chalet du XVI °.

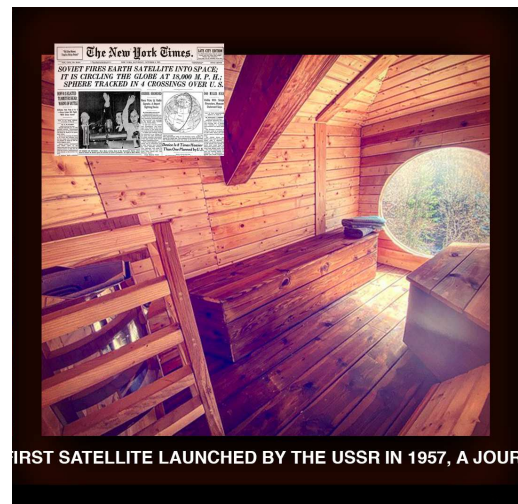
The Bel Air property was bought by Mr & Mrs Païs in the 2000s, Muriel Païs, native and proud of her origins, wishes to highlight the heritage and the history of her village, with the help of her architect husband, they rethink the building together over the years.

Atypical volumes have been fitted out in accordance with the trends of the time, a mixture of neo-brutalism and modernism for a revisited spirit of the 60s still clearly visible in our mountain villages.

Today, the Balzac apartment is nestled on the 2nd floor of this property, the name is a nod to the Dassault Balzac V-001 / Mirage III-V from the French manufacturer Dassault Aviation just like the other apartments at Chalet Bel Air, Mystère and Falcon.



Respecting the architectural style of the building and its character lines, Balzac apartment has been imagined and re-adapted by local artists and designers in an unexpected style and high-end comfort.



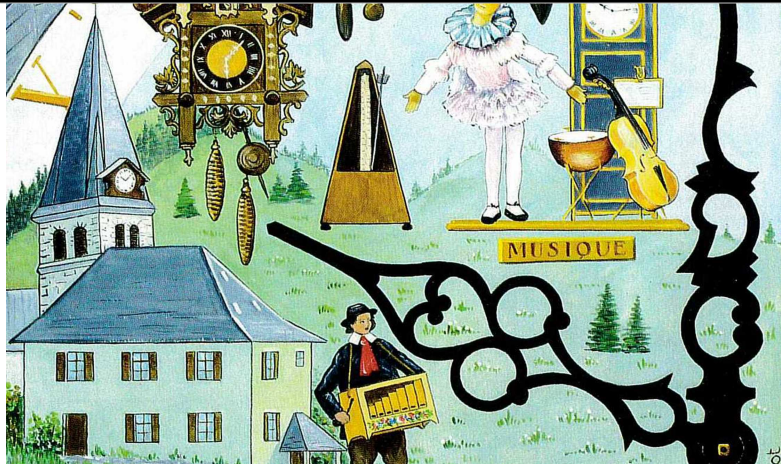
You will discover an architectural and artisanal feat in front of the apartment, called "спутник", "Sputnik", the sauna which will make you travel even further.

Referring to the first satellite launched by the USSR in 1957, the Sauna Sputnik was made using Scandinavian technique.

This unique work is consistent with the architecture of the 60s offered by the building and the theme of the different apartments that are housed there.

L'ABBAYE D'AULPS

The Abbey d'Aulps was founded at the end of the 11th century in the heart of the Chablais Prealps. The visitor is welcomed, as in the days of the monks, in the gatehouse of the domain. We discover archaeological information as well as the model of the domain, to appropriate 3 hectares of monastic space. On the first floor, the permanent exhibition is made up of 5 times that will take you into the world of the Abbey of Sainte-Marie des Alpes.

The Sainte-Marie d'Aulps Abbey is a real architectural treasure of medieval Savoy.

LAKE MONTRIOND



You cannot miss this incredible lake at 1,072 meters above sea level.

Each season has its own atmosphere, nestled between cliffs and pastures, it offers a magical setting.

On a 3 km path along its banks, you can walk without uneven, paddle in summer, cross-country skiing in winter and many other activities.

Montriond lake is an essential geo-site of the Geopark Chablais. Under these calm waters, Lake Montriond reveals an eventful history. As you stroll around Lake Montriond, you will discover the glacial history of the valley, the Ardent waterfall, the catastrophic formation of the lake, the Sardinian land register, but also the story of the extravagant Baron de l'Epée.

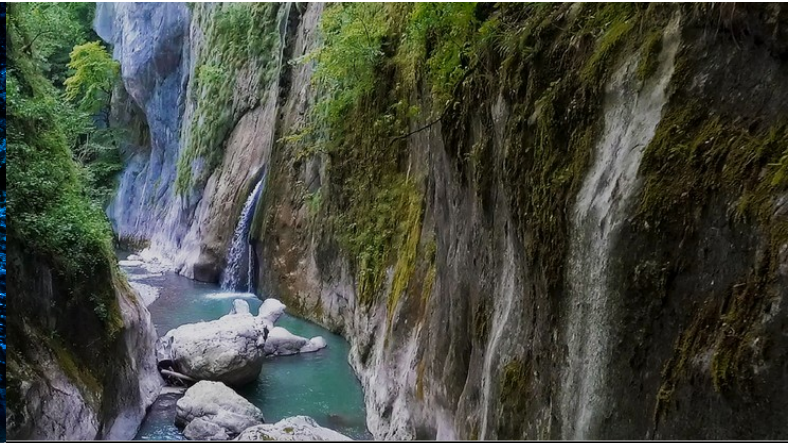
Montriond lake was born following the landslide of part of the Nantaux mountain in the North West.

This undated geological event with certainty (4500 years to 3 or 4 centuries) caused a dam on the torrent that ran at the bottom of the valley, hence the formation of the lake. Subject to very strong variations in levels between spring and autumn, the lake was finally sealed in 1990 by gigantic works carried out by the Municipality of Montriond. A cross in commemoration of the missing villagers is across the road.

THE GOATS VILLAGE

Nestled at an altitude of 1,467 m, the village of goats in Montriond is an unmissable place with incredible charm, this small hamlet of small typical chalets is populated all summer with goats in the wild and winter becomes accessible on skis with many restaurants with typical flavors of our mountains. Departing from the village of Lindarets, there are many hikes to discover in summer, in particular the legendary Brochoux waterfall which is located a 30-minute walk from the village.

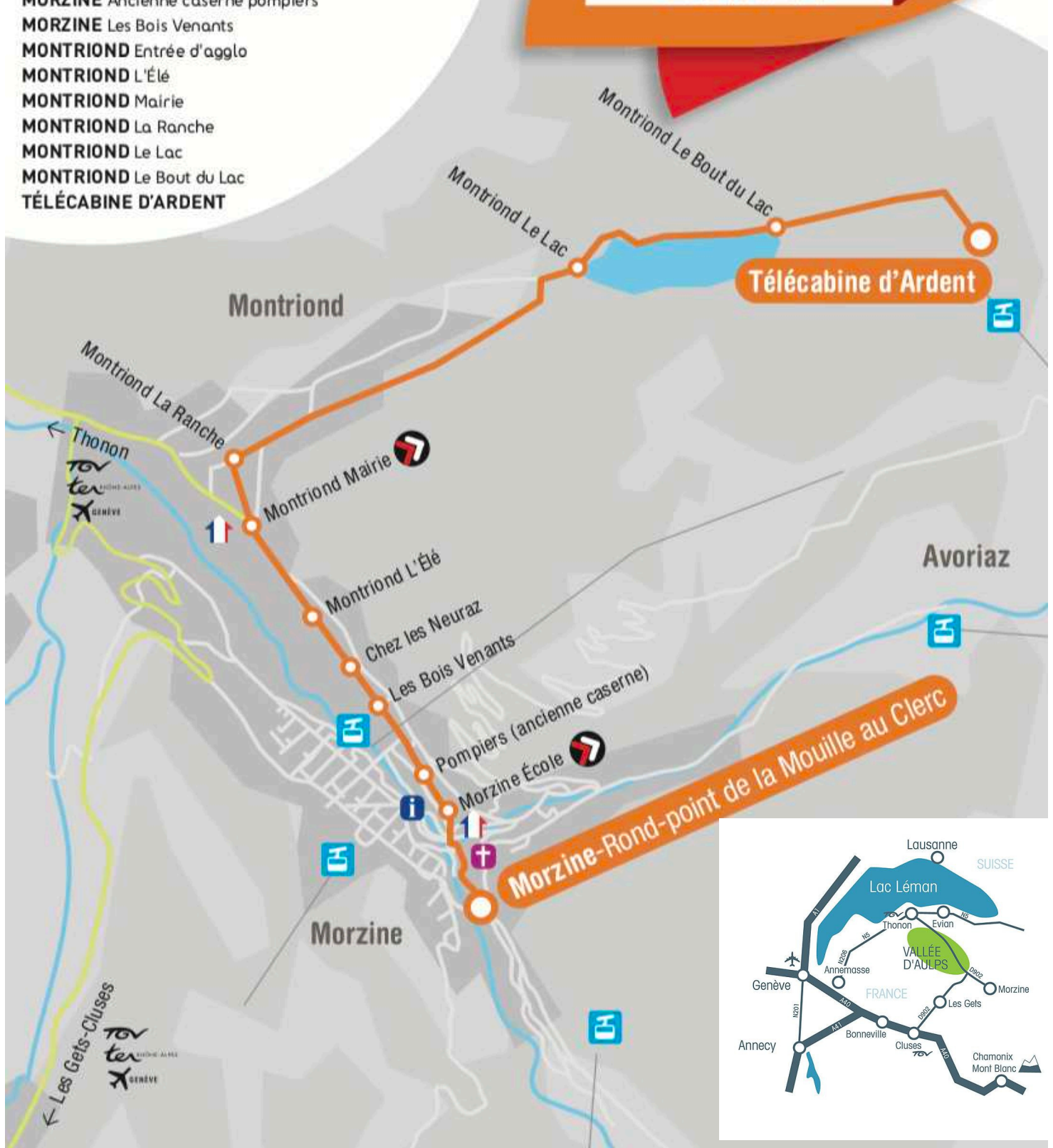

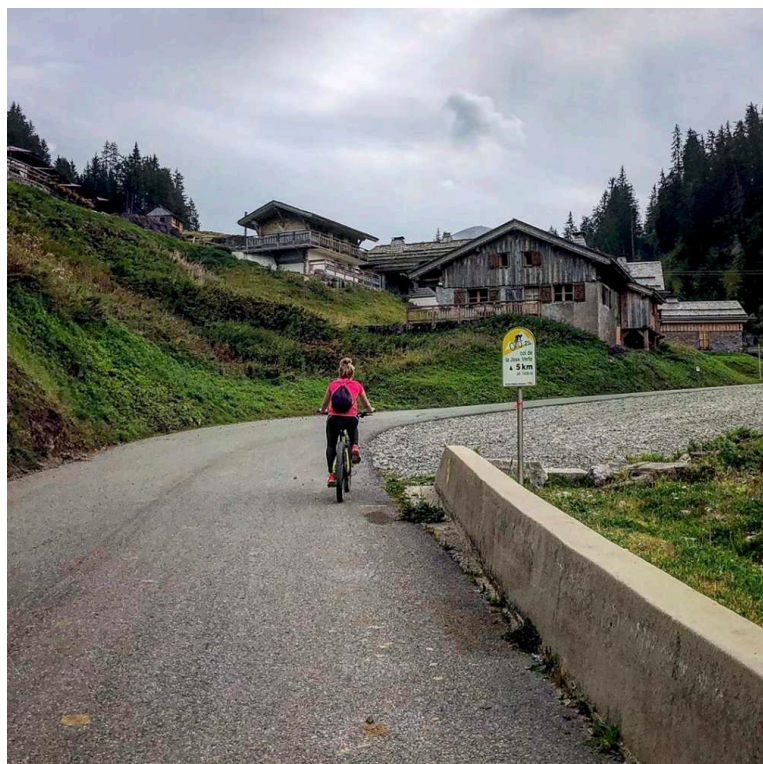

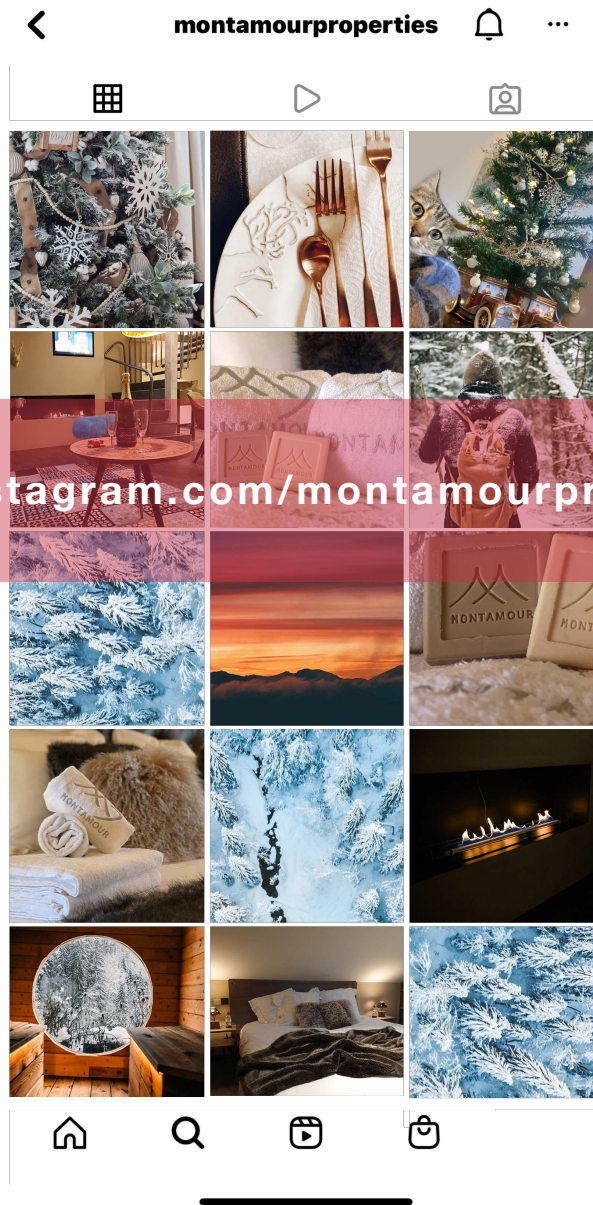

RECIPTS



A Savoyard Fondue

- . Cut the bread into small squares
- . Do not put your white wine in the fridge, leave it at room temperature before pouring it into your preparation
- . Rub the bottom of the fondue pot with the garlic clove cut in half
- . Place the fondue pot on the baking sheet over low heat and add a little white wine
- . Gradually add the cheese mixture, handful after handful, then alternate white wine and cheese, stirring with your wooden spatula, forming 8
- . Continue to stir, forming an 8 with your wooden spatula
- . Once the mixture is homogeneous, put the pot on the fondue stove that you will have pre-lit with gel or combustible paste
- . Use small pieces of bread and dip them with your forks



The Croziflette

- . Cook your Crozets in boiling water for 20 minutes (the same way as pasta)
- . Brown an onion in butter in a separate saucepan
- . Add 20 cl of crème fraîche to the onions and reduce
- . In your gratin dish, alternate between a layer of Crozets, a layer of onion cream
- . To finish, place the reblochon cut in half on this preparation
- . Cook around in the oven for 20 minutes at 200 ° C
- . This recipe can be adapted with bacon cooked in the cream / onion mixture

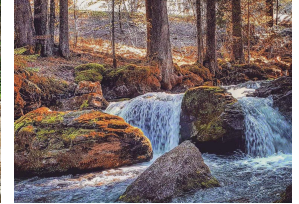
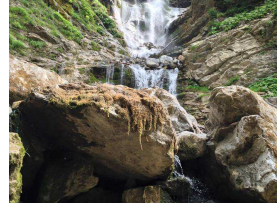

LEGENDS OF OUR MOUNTAINS



The legend of the Alpe dove

Once, this dove was carved by the shepherds who spent long months in the mountain pastures thinking of their beloved and as a proof of eternal love, offered them on their return.

This wooden bird with scalloped and fan-shaped wings is obtained by fitting together two pieces of spruce, one for the body and the tail, the other for the wings, it is entirely carved with the Opinel (traditional knife) .

Symbol of purity and simplicity, La Colombe evokes the soul, a vital principle of love, gentleness and peace.

Placed in the center of a house, it restores vibratory harmony.



The legend of the Chaufaton

Another one of those playful goblins who prey on sleepers lying on hay. The people of Montriond remember the Chaufaton as an oppressive goblin, who, when they attempted a nap in the barn, would lie on their chests, preventing them from moving and breathing. A small invisible being, already mentioned in the Middle Ages under the name of Folaton in the region of the Alps.

At the Péage de Vizile, during the night, the Folaton turned the spinning wheel and drew the milk from the cows and also haunted buildings, such as the factory of the Péage de Vizille, and sometimes he is identified with the devil.

The Chaufaton can be tamed by a household that respects him and if he feels loved he can even help with household chores, but there are more evil and very resentful Chaufatons who could take revenge on the man he does not love for one reason or another and thus have small stones on the edges of the baignolets in the chalets.

A prankster Chaufaton overflowing with evil ideas to make you go crazy.

The legend of the Dahu

The legend of the Dahu is said to lie halfway between the ibex and the chamois, it is an imaginary animal, as mysterious as the Yeti. Now that you know this legend, don't be fooled.



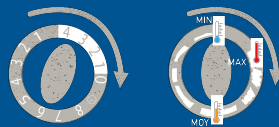


SAUNA



- Do not heat the stove longer than necessary
- Shower and soap yourself before starting the Sauna & dry yourself well before entering the Sauna, the session will be all the more effective
- For your comfort and for hygiene reasons, do not forget to put a large towel on which to sit
- Fill the bucket with cold water (or snow), then pour a few ladles of water over the hot stones to generate steam. **Only pour water on the stones when they are hot, NEVER pour water on cold stones.**
- The ideal temperature varies between 80 and 90 ° C. You can, however, adjust the temperature by turning the knob. Above all, listen carefully to your body, go out at the slightest sign of discomfort or a significant acceleration in your heartbeat
- It is advisable to do sessions of 5 to 10 minutes
- Get up slowly to avoid dizziness
- When the session is over, take a cold shower that will activate blood circulation, starting with the feet, never the head or the neck.
- Wait 5 minutes before entering the Sauna again
- You should always feel good, it is better to go home several times over a short period rather than once for a very long time
- Rest completely for 15 minutes and rehydrate your body by drinking cool water and you can hydrate your skin with a moisturizer
- Turn off the electric stove once the Sauna session is over


- . To enjoy the Sauna now, turn the time switch to the first part, white section of the figure. You can go until 4 a.m. Then turn on the heat switch.
- . Pour a ladle of water over the hot stones.
- . To schedule your session later, turn the other part, in gray in the figure. You can schedule a session for up to 8 a.m.



- . The Sauna buttons are located in the barrel on the device. Turn the knobs clockwise to turn on the Electric Stove.



SMART TV

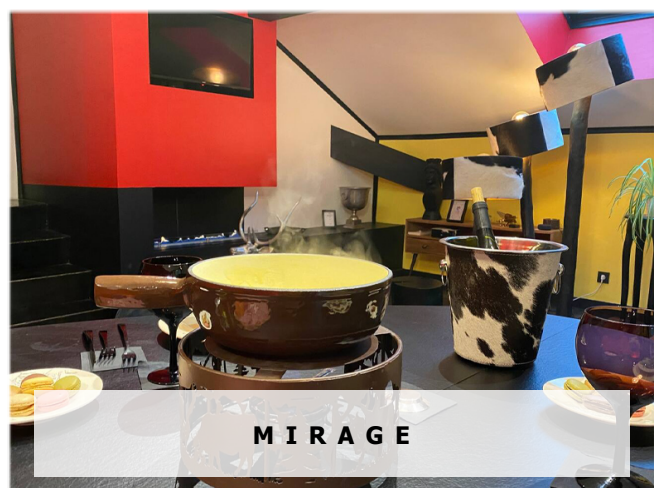
